Beneficiaries have often fled Domestic abuse, Family Breakdown, are moving out of furnished accommodation or were homeless. Referrals are received from Social Services, Chelmsford Foodbank, Housing Associations, Peabody, Social Prescribers, Essex Child & Family Wellbeing, Schools, etc.

Supplying furniture is just a small part of what we do with ongoing befriending services for individuals and families, social occasions, experiences and activities



Our project is reliant upon donations of furniture, appliances and househol tems. The majority of our items are second hand, all checked and electric safety tested where needed. We provide some items such as Cookers an Carpets brand new, funded by Acts435 Christian Crowdfunding websits Unfortunately many people are living in Furniture Poverty. We estimate ow 12,000 people in Chelmsford live without at least one Essential appliance.
